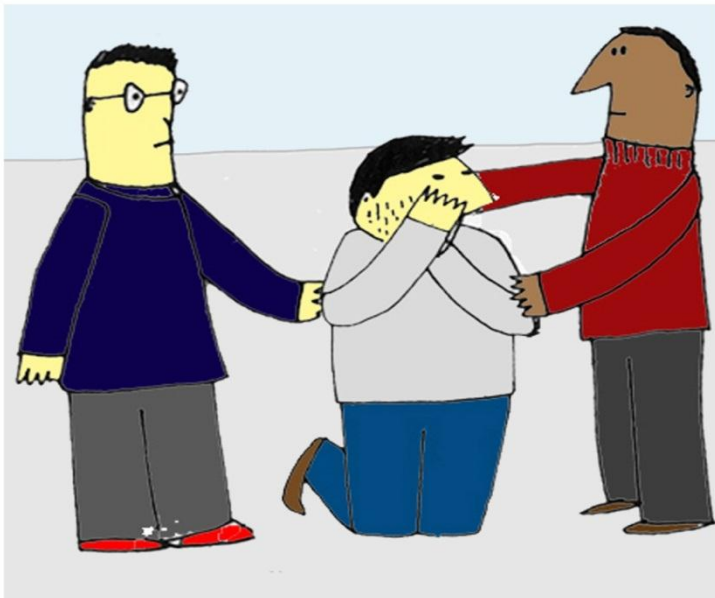

He wanted Jesus to use him.

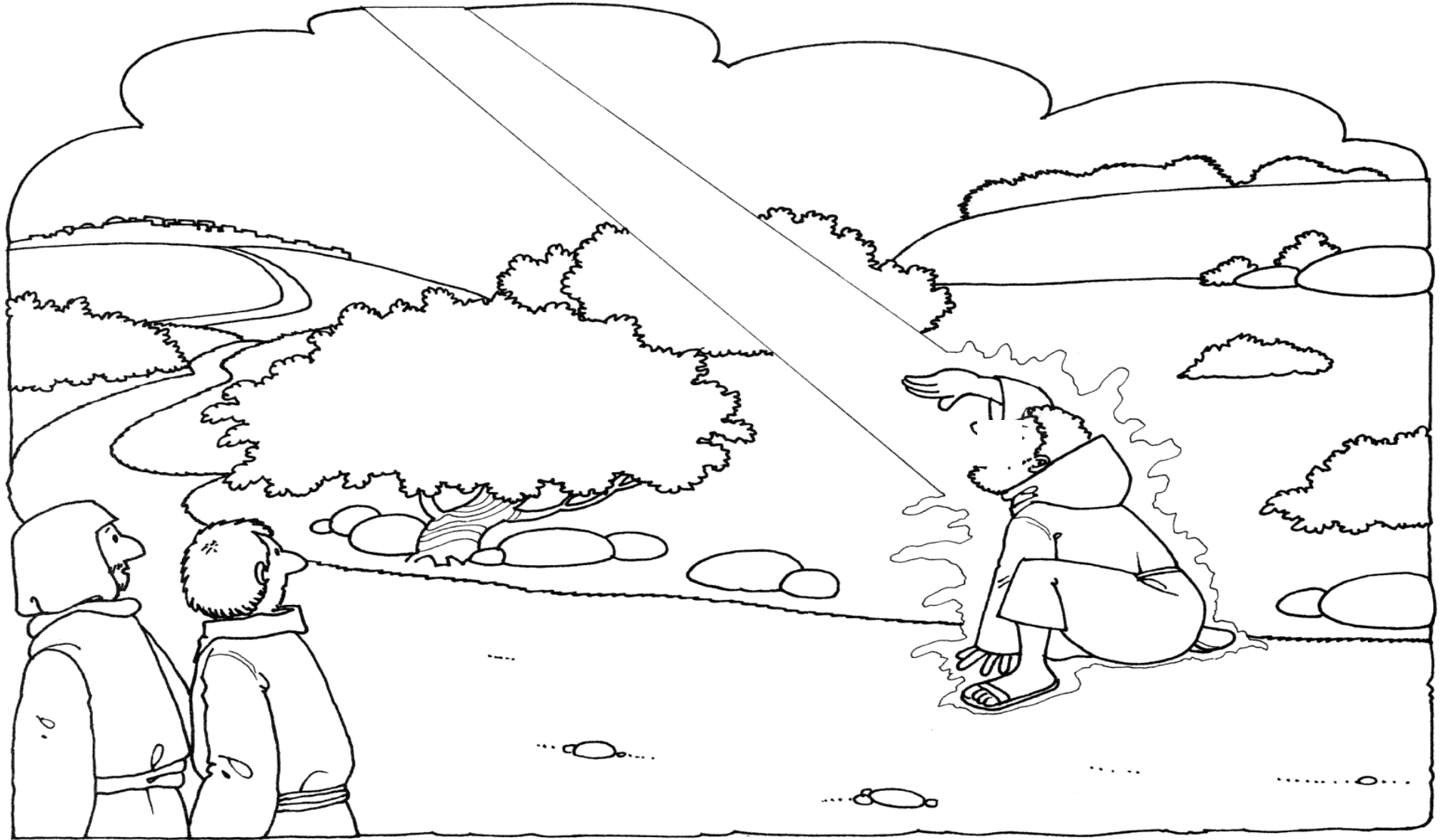
Ananias found Saul and prayed for him to see again.

He was sorry that he had tried to hurt Jesus' friends.



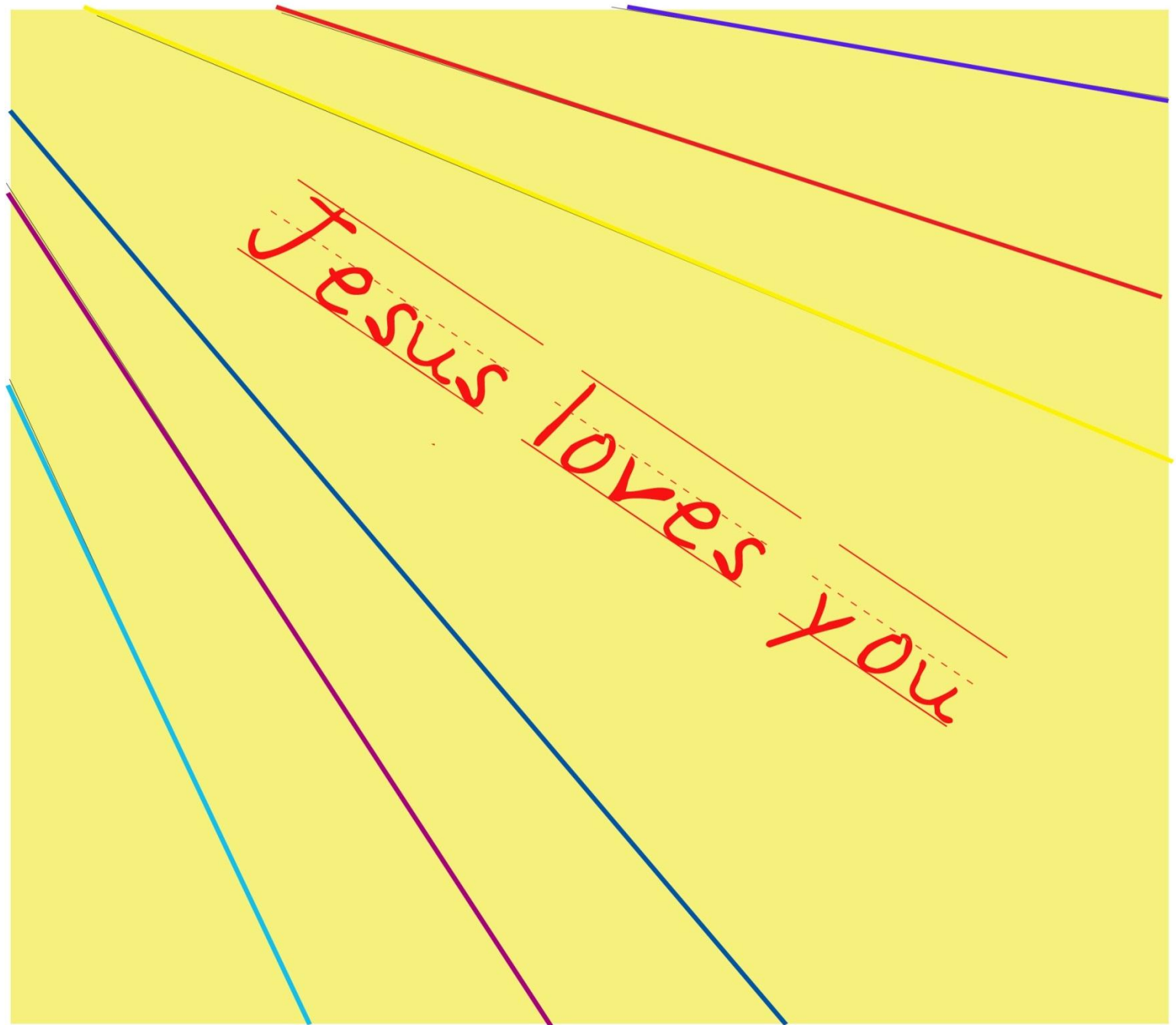
From that day on Saul traveled around telling everybody about Jesus.
