





Jesus loved to tell people stories:


He told stories to let people know what God is like. He told stories to tell people what would happen. He told stories to help people know what to do.


People loved to listen to Jesus' stories.


One time Jesus told this story to show that although it may look small on earth, God's kingdom will grow to be very big.

MAKE A DOVE

You will need: An adult to help 1 x sheet of card 1 x sheet of paper Scissors Pencil String Clear tape Colouring pencils, Glitter



1. Draw the shape of the body onto card

2. Cut out and cut the 2 x slits (dotted lines)

3. Cut the sheet of paper in half

4. Fold each piece like an acordian M

5. Insert the folded paper (wings and tails) into the slits in the birds body secure them with clear tape.

Tape the ends of the tail feathers together to make a fan Draw eyes on the dove

6. Tape some string to the body of the dove for hanging
